The Rural Municipality of Prince Albert No. 461 has received a Temporary Discretionary Use Application from HJR Asphalt Inc. for the operation of a Temporary Asphalt Plant.

The proposed asphalt plant is intended to support future improvements to Highway 302 East, from 15th Avenue East to Spencer Grid. The temporary site is proposed to be located north of Sunshine Road at the Weststar Group of Companies property.

The operation is expected to occur for a period of two to three weeks in August or September 2026, subject to project scheduling. The plant will include a baghouse system to control dust and airborne pollutants. During operation, truck traffic is anticipated to depart the site approximately every 7–10 minutes, with appropriate signage in place within the construction zone to notify motorists of turning vehicles.

The asphalt plant will operate during daylight hours and will comply with the RM of Prince Albert Noise Bylaw, with operating hours limited to 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekdays and 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekends. Portable washrooms and waste facilities will be provided for on-site staff.

You are receiving this notice because you are an assessed property owner in close proximity to the proposed development. As a neighbouring landowner, your comments are important and will be considered by RM Council as part of its review of the application.





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Council will hold a public hearing on Thursday, February 12 at 1:00 p.m. at the RM of Prince Albert Municipal Centre, to hear any person or group that wishes to comment on the proposed discretionary use application. Council will also consider written comments received at or prior to the hearing. All comments received become public records and are considered in a public meeting.

Discretionary Use Application – Temporary Asphalt Plant site

HJR Asphalt proposes to mobilize and operate a portable asphalt plant on Blk/Par HH-Plan 101466457 Ext 68 for the purpose of paving on Hwy 302 East from 15th Avenue to Spencer Grid. The Asphalt plant would be set up on the north side of the property.

- **Traffic Volumes**

During production there will be approximately one truckload of hot-mix asphalt leaving the plant every 7-10 minutes. There will be deliveries of asphalt oil and fuel to the site on average of four truck loads per day.

- **Lighting and signage**

Truck turning signs will be erected on Hwy 302 on either side of the approach to warn traffic of trucks turning on and off the highway. Signage at the entrance to the site will show “HJR Asphalt Plant Site” and a contact phone number.

- **Operation Details**

The asphalt plant would be on location for two to three weeks sometime in August or September of 2026 (depending on project progress). During this time, the plant would be operated only during daylight hours and would abide by municipal noise bylaws.

- **Impact on Surroundings**

HJR is committed to minimizing nuisances for residents in the surrounding area. The asphalt plant uses a baghouse, which is a dust and pollution control system. The plant will not operate outside of the RM of Prince Albert noise bylaw hours.

- **Waste Disposal**

Portable dumpsters and toilets will be used to keep the site tidy. All materials and equipment will be removed from site upon completion of the project.
