The Rural Municipality of Prince Albert No. 461 has received a Temporary Discretionary Use application from HJR Asphalt Inc. for a gravel stockpile site. The gravel is proposed to be stockpiled for use in the future improvement of Highway 302 East, from 15th Avenue East to the Spencer Grid.

The proposal includes the stockpiling of approximately 10,000 tonnes of gravel, anticipated to occur in February and March 2026, with the material to be used for road construction during the summer of 2026. The site will be cleaned up and returned to its original condition by the end of 2026.

During stockpiling, there will be approximately 250 semi-truck loads delivered over the course of one week. Dust control measures will include the use of water trucks as required. Truck turning signs will be installed along Highway 302 to warn motorists of trucks entering and exiting the site. All operations will comply with the RM of Prince Albert Noise Bylaw, with operating hours limited to 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekdays and 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekends.

You are receiving this notice because you are an assessed property owner in close proximity to the proposed development. As a neighbouring landowner, your comments are important and will be considered by RM Council as part of its review of the application.





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Council will hold a public hearing on Thursday, February 12 at 1:05 p.m. at the RM of Prince Albert Municipal Centre, to hear any person or group that wishes to comment on the proposed discretionary use application. Council will also consider written comments received at or prior to the hearing. All comments received become public records and are considered in a public meeting.

Discretionary Use Application – Temporary Stockpile Site

HJR Asphalt proposes to stockpile gravel at this location for the purpose of construction on Hwy 302 East. The proposal is for approximately 10,000 tonnes of gravel to be hauled to the site in February/March and be placed on the road summer of 2026. The site will be cleaned up and returned to its original state by the end of 2026.

- **Traffic Volumes**

During stockpiling there will be approximately 250 semi loads of gravel brought in over the course of one week. In the summer months (May-August) there will be occasional loads of gravel taken from this site to be used on the road.

- **Lighting and signage**

Truck turning signs will be erected on Hwy 302 on either side of the approach to warn traffic of trucks turning on and off the highway.

- **Operation Details**

There will be a loader on site and trucks entering/exiting the property during times of stockpiling the gravel and during times where gravel is being spread on the highway.

- **Impact on Surroundings**

HJR is committed to minimizing nuisances for residents in the surrounding area. A water truck will be on site during construction for dust control. The equipment will not operate outside of the RM of Prince Albert noise bylaw hours.

- **Waste Disposal**

All materials and equipment will be removed from site upon completion of the project.
